- 1. The bridleway over the land situate in Summerhouse and shown on the attached map and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order ('the Schedule') shall be stopped up after 14 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
- 2. There shall at the end of 14 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public bridleway over the land situate in Summerhouse and shown on the attached map and described in Part 2 of the Schedule.


