

**DARLINGTON BOROUGH COUNCIL
(PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY NO. 7,
PARISH OF SUMMERHOUSE)
DIVERSION ORDER 2015**

This Order is made by Darlington Borough Council under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 because it appears to the authority that it is in the interests of the owners and occupiers of the land crossed by the bridleway described in paragraph 1 of this Order and the public and it is expedient that the lines of the bridleway should be diverted.

Summerhouse Development Property Sales of 81 Bondgate, Darlington DL3 7JT have agreed to contribute towards any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the bridleway into a fit condition for use by the public.

BY THIS ORDER

1. The bridleway over the land situate in Summerhouse and shown on the attached map and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order ('the Schedule') shall be stopped up after 14 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall at the end of 14 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public bridleway over the land situate in Summerhouse and shown on the attached map and described in Part 2 of the Schedule.

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITES OF EXISTING BRIDLEWAY IN SUMMERHOUSE

Bridleway No. 7	From Point A, NZ 20288 19072 north and east across a former farm yard towards buildings, to Point B, NZ 20318 19087 and then roughly ENE across a field for about 90 metres to finish at Point C, NZ 20405 19103. Width – 3 metres where defined

DESCRIPTION OF SITES OF NEW BRIDLEWAY IN SUMMERHOUSE

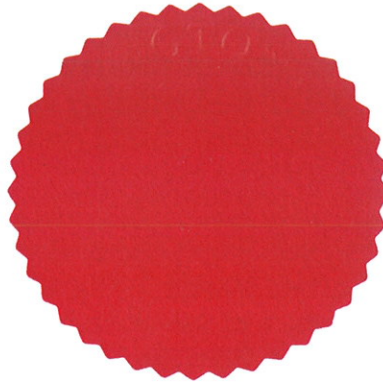
Bridleway No. 7	From Point A, NZ 20288 19072, then ENE to a bridle gate at Point D NZ 20294 19073, and then roughly ENE across a field for about 115 metres to finish at Point C, NZ 20405 19103. The width is 3 metres.

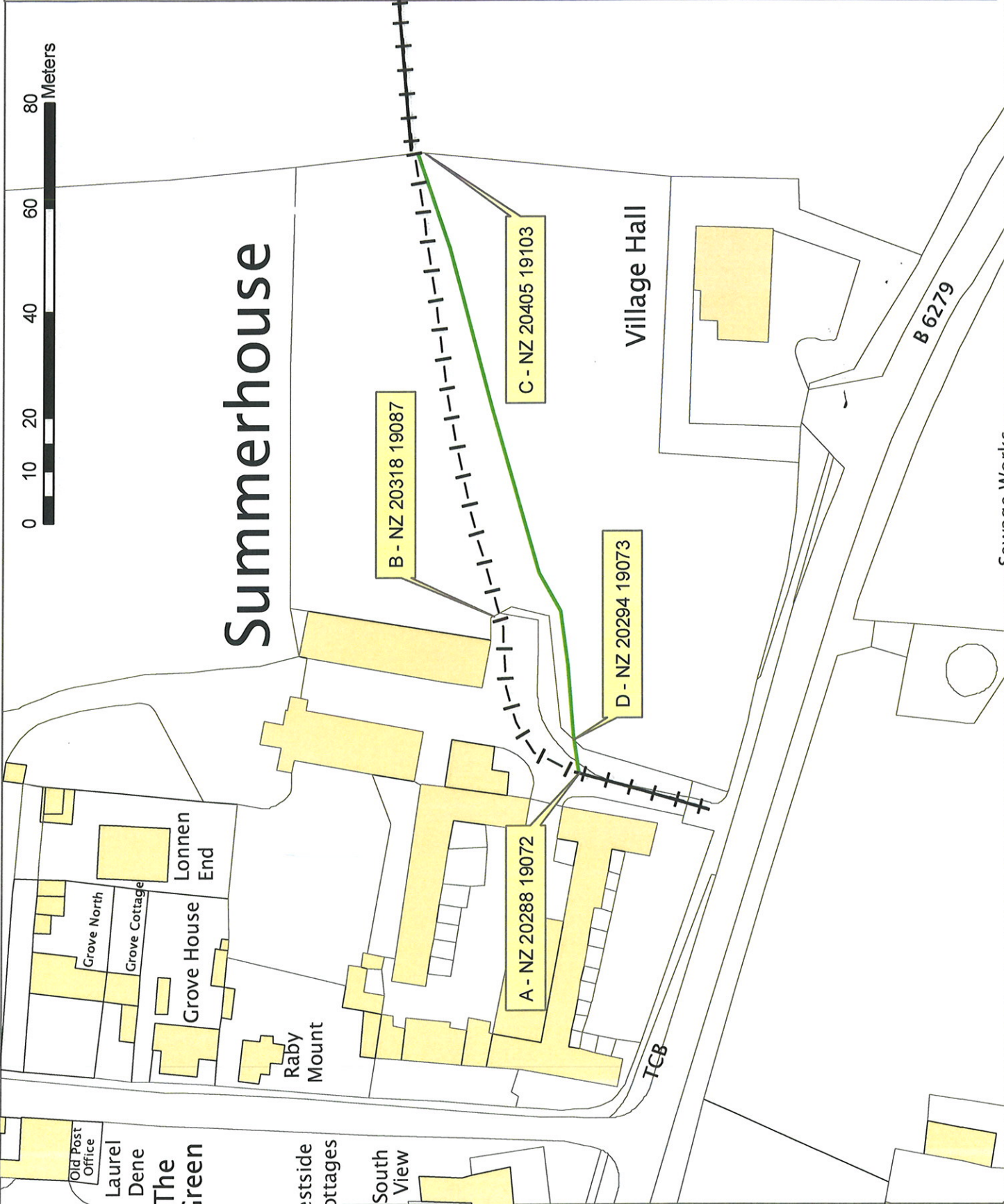
