- **Infant mortality:** Mortality rate per 1,000 live births (age under 1 year), 2011-2013
- Child mortality rate (1-17 years): Directly standardised rate per 100,000 children age 1-17 years, 2011-2013
- MMR vaccination for one dose (2 years): % children immunised against measles, mumps and rubella (first dose by age 2 years), 2013/14
- Dtap / IPV / Hib vaccination (2 years): % children completing a course of immunisation against diphtheria, tetanus, polio, pertussis and Hib by age 2 years, 2013/14
- Children in poverty (under 16 years): % of children aged under 16 living in families in receipt of out of work benefits or tax credits where their reported income is less than 60% median income, 2012
- Children killed or seriously injured in road traffic accidents: Crude rate of children age 0-15 years who were killed or seriously injured in road traffic accidents per 100,000 population, 2011-2013
- Low birthweight of all babies: Percentage of live and stillbirths weighing less than 2,500 grams, 2013
- Obese children (4-5 years): % school children in Reception year classified as obese, 2013/14
- Obese children (10-11 years): % school children in Year 6 classified as obese, 2013/14
- **Teenage mothers:** % of delivery episodes where the mother is aged less than 18 years, 2013/14
- Hospital admissions due to substance misuse (15-24 years): Directly standardised rate per 100,000 (age 15-24 years) for hospital admissions for substance misuse, 2011/12-2013/14

- **Smoking status at time of delivery:** % of mothers smoking at time of delivery, 2013/14
- **Breastfeeding initiation:** % of mothers initiating breastfeeding, 2013/14
- Breastfeeding prevalence at 6-8 weeks after birth: % of mothers breastfeeding at 6-8 weeks, 2013/14
- **A&E attendances (0-4 years):** Crude rate per 1,000 (age 0-4 years) of A&E attendances, 2013/14
- Hospital admissions caused by injuries in children (0-14 years):
  Crude rate per 10,000 (age 0-14 years) for emergency hospital admissions following injury, 2013/14
- Hospital admissions caused by injuries in young people (15-24 years): Crude rate per 10,000 (age 15-24 years) for emergency hospital admissions following injury, 2013/14
- Hospital admissions for asthma (under 19 years): Crude rate per 100,000 (age 0-18 years) for emergency hospital admissions for asthma, 2013/14
- Hospital admissions for mental health conditions: Crude rate per 100,000 (age 0-17 years) for hospital admissions for mental health, 2013/14
- Hospital admissions as a result of self-harm (10-24 years):
  Directly standardised rate per 100,000 (age 10-24 years) for hospital admissions for self-harm, 2013/14
